

# Investing for Success

**Under this agreement for 2019  
Kilcoy State School will receive**

**\$229,797\***

## This funding will be used to

- Increase Years 3 and 5 achievement in NAPLAN Reading Mean Scale Score (MSS) from numerically below national MSS (2018) to be numerically at or above national MSS.
- Increase the number of students in Years 3 and 5 achieving results in the Upper Two Bands (U2B) for NAPLAN Reading from 25% and 14%, to 35% and 30%.
- Increase the number of students in Years 3 and 5 achieving results in the U2B for NAPLAN Numeracy from 7% and 12% to 20% and 25%.
- Employment of Speech Language Pathologist for an additional 0.1 full time equivalent.
- Employment of a teacher aide to support speech program.

## Our initiatives include

- Develop a shared understanding of “data literacy” and support teachers to effectively use data to inform targeted teaching.
- Development of targeted strategies to increase and extend students achieving results in the U2Bs.
- Employment of an additional classroom teacher.
- Develop an explicit teaching of thinking and reasoning program within curriculum units to develop higher order literacy.
- Employment of an additional 0.1 Speech Language Pathologist for 2019.
- Specialised speech teacher aide for 24hr/week for intensive support.

Employment of 0.1 Speech Language Pathologist	\$15 000
Employment of teacher aide for speech intervention	\$35 000
Professional development of staff in data literacy and U2B strategies	\$90 000
Support for the 13 <sup>th</sup> classroom teacher	\$40 000
Resources for U2B program	\$49 797
