STUDENT DRESS CODE

Kilcoy State School revised its uniform in 2005. The P & C set up a committee which sought parent feedback on changes and in turn designed a new day and formal uniform.

The P & C fully supports the current uniform and dress code. The parent group believes that the children can show their school pride through the wearing of a smart, modern uniform.

The correct school uniform should be worn each day. The day/formal uniforms, hats and green fleecy jumpers can be purchased from the school tuckshop.

Students must also adhere to the following policies: -

Wearing of Jewellery

Jewellery wearing should be restricted to the wearing of a wristwatch. Other items of jewellery may constitute an impediment to the safety and well-being of students. If teachers consider that there is any foreseeable danger then children will be asked to remove jewellery. **Ostentatious rings, bracelets and necklaces should not be worn to school.**

The only facial jewellery which can be worn is discrete rings and studs in the earlobes. Children are not to wear nose rings, studs, eyebrow rings or studs or tongue/lip rings. These items represent potential risks which the school wants to avoid.

Student Hair Style & Colouring

Students' hair should be well kept and maintained. Students are not permitted to have extreme hair styles or hair shaving at Kilcoy State School. Mohawk hair styles are not allowed. Bleaching or ostentatious colouring is not accepted. Students can use hair dye to colour hair for inter-house sports events and selected student performances. Students with extreme hair styles/cuts/shaves or inappropriate colouring will be required to have them adjusted to conform to school expectations.

- Shirt: White formal shirt with green pin stripe and trim.
- Shorts: Bottle Green (NOT 3/4 length)
- Socks: White socks.
- Shoes: Black multi-purpose.
- Hat: Bottle green bucket hat

- Either of the above and green and gold fleecy jumper.
- Tracksuit pants/slacks: Green
